




Thumbs Up to the New Year! **Looking Back and Looking Forward**

ALL WAYS UP Awards \$700,000 in Grants and Welcomes Five New Community Partners

Late last year, All Ways Up awarded \$700,000 in grants to 37 community partners as part of the annual Bridging the Gap Awards. Each of the awardees provides programs that are closely aligned with our mission: to help low-income and first-generation youth get to and through college. The non-profit organizations are located in nine states, including California, Colorado, Maryland, Ohio and Tennessee. We are thrilled to welcome five new partners: Academy for Success, Al Wooten Jr. Youth Center, College Access Partnership, Inc., Next Generation Scholars and On a Mission.

In addition to the grant awards, fifteen of our partners were selected to participate in a crowdfunding campaign in which All Ways Up matched the funds raised by each organization. We are thrilled to report that all 15 organizations reached their goals and All Ways Up matched a total of \$185,000. As community partners, the students that participate in their programs are now eligible to apply for an All Ways Up Scholarship and attendance at the annual UP Through Education Summit. This year's Summit will once again be held on the campus of Loyola Marymount University from June 24 - June 28.

Internship Support

Beginning this summer, All Ways Up will provide stipends to scholars who secure careerfocused internships. The benefits of a summer internship are far-reaching, but sometimes our scholars are forced to make difficult choices because of financial need. To help alleviate this concern, All Ways Up will provide stipends to students who work a minimum of twenty hours per week for at least one month. The stipends will range from \$500 to \$1,500.
